**Environment** is an inclusive concept which includes all biotic and abiotic factors that influence each other. While all living elements like birds, animals and plants, forests and fisheries etc. are biotic elements, abiotic elements include air, water, land, rocks, sunlight etc.

**Global warming** is a gradual increase in the average temperature of the earth's lower atmosphere as a result of the increase in greenhouse gases since the Industrial Revolution. Much of the recent global warming is human induced. It is caused by human made increase in carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases through the burning of fossil fuels and deforestation.

#### **Causes of Global Warming**

- Burning of coal and petroleum (sources of carbon dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, ozone)
- Deforestation (which increases amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere)
- Methane gas released in animal waste
- Increased cattle production
