6.	DESCRIPTION	<p>The revolt of 1857, though started with Sepoy Mutiny, has been marked as the INDIAN WAR OF INDEPENDENCE. It engulfed large part of the Indian subcontinent with the participation of people.</p> <p>People need orientation and direction, which were shown by their leaders. These leaders belonged to varied sections of the society. Of course they joined the rebellion to reap the benefits of the outcome of the revolt.</p> <p>But people saw this as an alternative and felt inspired and enthused by their leaders. There were other unknown leaders who kept supporting the main leaders with their reinforcement and encouragement.</p> <p>Rebellion had occurred earlier prior to 1857 like Sanyasi Rebellion or Chunar rebellion or Peasants movement of Moplah and the Faraizi movement. But the first expression of organised resistance was the Revolt of 1857. It was organized because of the leadership.</p>

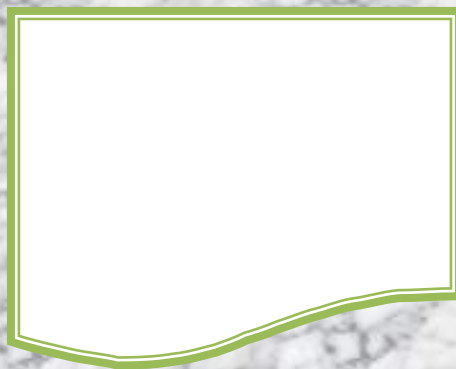
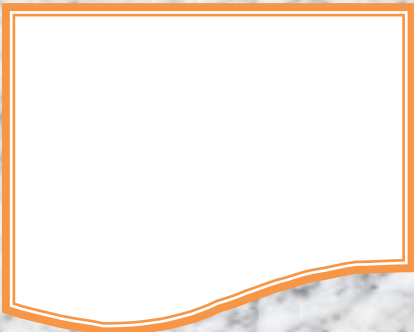

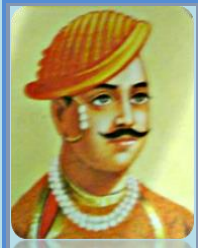

KEY WORDS

INDIAN WAR OF INDEPENDENCE	<i>This term was first time used by Veer Savarkar for the revolt of 1857.</i>
SEPOY MUTINY	<i>Soldiers rebelling against its authority. British historian used this term for the revolt of 1857.</i>
SANYASI REBELLION	<i>It occurred in the province of Bengal. It was led by monks and dispossessed zamindars and later joined by the soldiers and oppressed peasants and finds mention in Anandmath authored by Bankim Chandra Chatterjee.</i>
FARAIZI MOVEMENT	<i>This movement was a religious reform movement started by Haji Shariatullah in Bengal. The movement protected the rights of tenants to a great extent.</i>
MOPLAH REBELLION	<i>It is also called Malabar or Mappila rebellion. It is a series of rebellion by the peasantry against the landlords and the State.</i>
ZAMINDAR	<i>An aristocratic landholder, who had control over the peasants and extracted tax for the military purpose.</i>
CHUNAR REBELLION	<i>It occurred in Bihar and Bengal in late eighteenth century.</i>
