### **An Overview**

- The foundation of the first empire in India was laid by the Mauryan dynasty in Magadha. Chandragupta Maurya became the first Mauryan ruler after overthrowing Dhana Nanda.
- One of the important effects of Alexander's invasion was the destruction of small kingdoms which helped in the establishment of a new empire.
- Megasthenes in his book Indica and Chanakya in Arthashastra have given detailed accounts of the administrative, political, economic and military system of the Mauryan Empire.
- Chandragupta ruled for about 24 years after which he gave up his throne to his son Bindusara. Bindusara was succeeded by Ashoka.
- Ashoka is regarded as one of the greatest rulers of the world.
- He waged a war on Kalinga and this war changed him from a great warrior to a great advocate of peace.
- Ashoka became an ardent follower of the Buddha's teachings. He built many stupas and viharas.
- Most of Ashoka's edicts are about dhamma which was a code of conduct and a way of life.
- The Mauryan Empire comprised of four provinces. The provincial government was under the control of princes.
- The Mauryan art and architecture was quite advanced. It is reflected in the Ashokan Pillars, Stupas, Lion thrones, Cave residences.
- The Mauryan Empire started to decline after the death of Ashoka because his successors lacked the ability to efficiently run the large empire.
